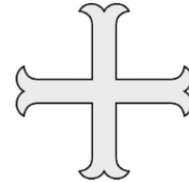

At Seton Parish, we are excited to help keep that tradition alive by hosting Hearts & Hammers Work Camp, July 22-26, 2026.

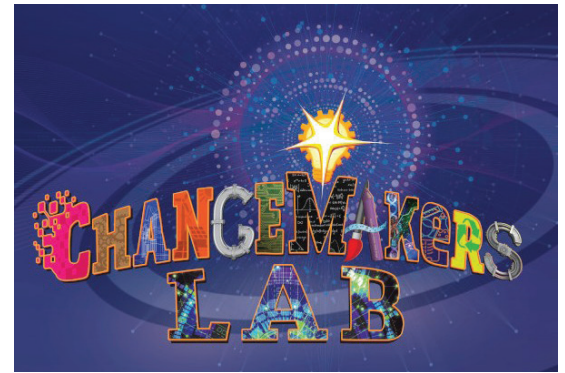
This event gives teens the opportunity to help members of our community with projects around their homes, while growing in faith, friendship, and service.

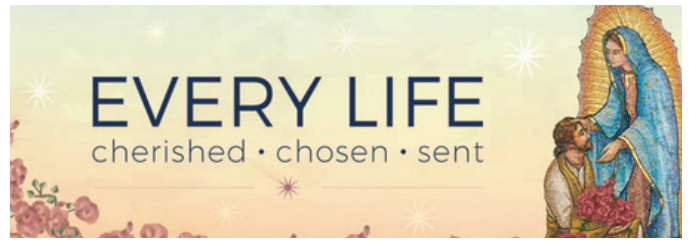
SPIRIT OF PEACE

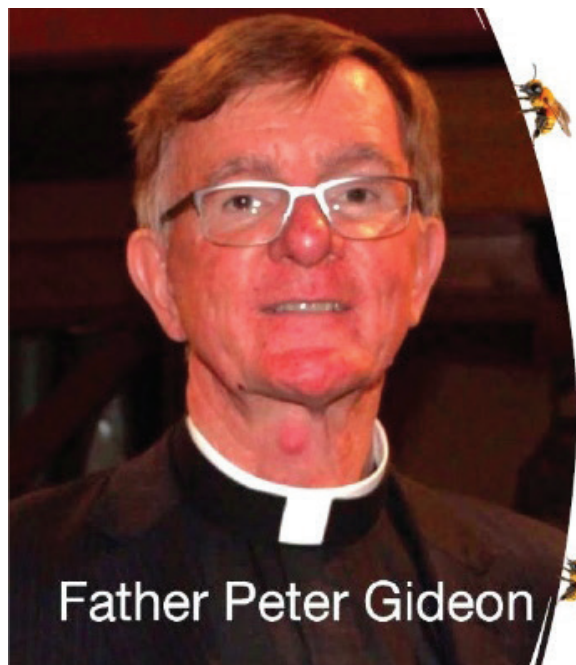


