## MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

Blessings of peace from your iTHIRST companions! We continue forward together as a community filled with hope during the month of Mental Health Awareness. It is only with struggle and surrender that we can truly attain freedom from what ails each of us in our day-to-day balance of joy and suffering in this life. We lift up our voices in gratitude for vulnerability with the person of Jesus. We sit beside Him in friendship and lay our hearts out before Him. Our ability to be whole comes from our trust in His love for us to see us through in our healing walk.

The theme for Mental Health Awareness Month is "See the Person. Support the Journey." This week we focus on the importance of early support as we learn to recognize signs in children and youth:

- Parents and caregivers are often the first to notice changes. Paying attention to patterns, having open conversations, and connecting children and teens to support early can make a meaningful difference.
- Changes in mood, sleep, appetite, thinking, or behavior may signal the need for support.
- Most serious mental illnesses begin in young adulthood.
- Exposure to trauma can affect long-term mental health.
- Timely assessment and access to services improve outcomes.
- Community awareness strengthens early identification and support.
- Young people thrive when support comes early. Asking for help on behalf of a child, teen, or young adult is an act of protection and advocacy.

The men and women of the iTHIRST ministry in the Diocese of Columbus are here to be your advocates, your listening ears, your silent partners on a journey that can seem so very dark. We draw from Christ's light to help be a beacon on your road to hope, and invite you to say yes to vulnerability, sharing in a confidential space and removing the veil that holds you captive to unnatural attachments in your life and your family's lives.

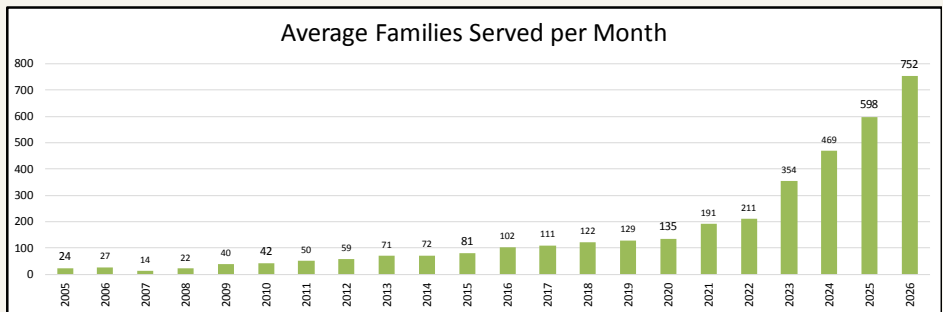

**CHARITABLE WORKS MINISTRY NEWS**

~ **Recap of April 2026** – We are continuing to see growing demand for food by families in the area. We (again) set a new record in April by feeding **832 families** (previous record was 790 from last month) comprised of 2,301 individuals. Thus far, we have served over 3,000 families in 2026. That is more than the number of families we served in all of 2022. We continue to strive to find deals at Mid-Ohio and are able to maintain our cost per individual, per week at less than \$10.00. Average weight of a box of food for a family for a week is about 50 pounds. Rather than share the usual graphs, below is one that shows the monthly average of families served by year, back to 2005. The numbers may be difficult to read, but the trend is quite amazing.



In April, we also delivered three pickup loads of clothing, household items, and books to the Bishop Griffin Center, Cecil's (free) Café at St. Dominic, and the Open Shelter. The list of items requested for the rest of the year is on our parish website at <https://stmatthew.net/cwm> as well as a SignUpGenius to help sort, pack, and deliver.

Our normal hours of operation are from **10:00 a.m. – noon, Monday – Friday and 6:00-8:00 p.m. on Thursday**. We are located within the PSC building (the old convent). All are welcome to visit the location to observe what we do and, if the Spirit moves you, become a part of our Ministry. We are always in need of more volunteers.

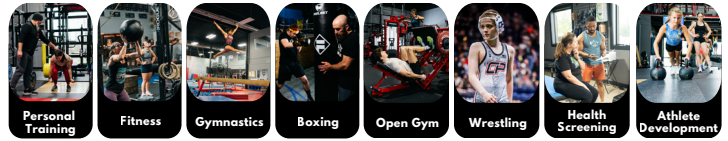
