FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

For the Gospel today, we have the Parable of the Sower and the Seed. Any experienced farmer knows that seed is precious. No sensible farmer would deliberately throw seed on a footpath, on rocks or among thorn bushes. Yet, Jesus describes a Sower who seems almost extravagant. He scatters the seed everywhere.

This is how God loves us. God does not wait until we become perfect before speaking to us. He sows this grace into every human heart – the faithful and the doubtful, the saint and the sinner, the young and the old. His love is never calculated. His mercy is never limited. God's patience is greater than our weakness.

At the end of today's Gospel, Jesus says "Whoever has ears ought to hear." God speaks continually. He speaks through sacred scripture. He speaks through the church. He speaks through our conscience. He speaks through the poor and the suffering. Sometimes, He even speaks through our failures and disappointments. The problem is not that God is silent; the problem is that our lives are often too noisy to hear Him.

The Gospel also reminds us that fruitfulness is the goal. God is not only interested in planting seeds; He desires a harvest. Christ is the Sower who sows His life into us so that we may become faithful disciples. Let us pray that our hearts may be good soil to bear lasting fruits.

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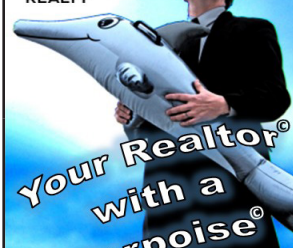
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
