The Profession of Faith

209. What is meant by the term "heaven"?

Father Matthew N. Hoover, Pastor of Seton Parish, was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop James Griffin at St. Joseph Cathedral in Columbus on June 24, 1995.

During his priestly ministry, Fr. Matt has served as pastor of several parishes throughout the Diocese of Columbus, including parishes in Scioto County, St. Joseph in Dover, and most recently Immaculate Conception in Columbus.

He enjoys all outdoor activities like hiking, fishing, skiing and hunting to name a few and has fond memories of time spent outside with his three siblings.

Meet Dcn. Kennedy

Deacon Kennedy Ofezu is a native of Uganda and the third of eight children in a Catholic family. His parents, four brothers, and three sisters still live in Uganda, where he grew up helping his family on their farm.

His vocation began when he was about seven years old. During a school Mass, a priest asked who wanted to become a priest. Deacon Kennedy raised his hand and was called forward while the other students prayed for him. Although some classmates laughed, he never forgot that moment. From then on, he faithfully attended Sunday Mass, prayed the family Rosary, served at the altar, and continued to follow God's call.

After studying in Uganda and Kenya and serving in parish ministry and religious education, he came to the United States in August 2023 to continue his formation for the Diocese of Columbus. His home parish is St. Joseph Cathedral. He completed his Master of Divinity at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Cincinnati and was ordained a transitional deacon on March 14, 2026.

Deacon Kennedy is grateful to be serving families and looks forward to praying with you, getting to know you, and growing together in faith as he continues his journey toward the priesthood.

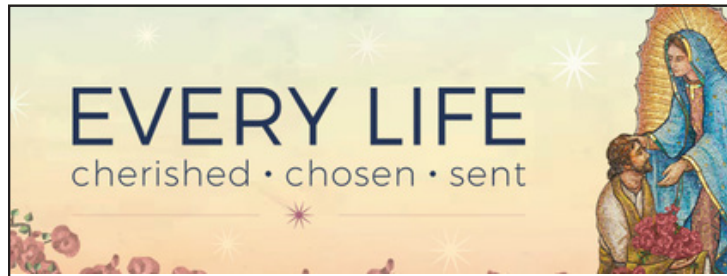
