CHARITABLE WORKS MINISTRY NEWS

~ **Recap of June 2026** – Demand remained strong in June as we served 795 families comprised of 2,219 individuals. We have served nearly 4,600 families YTD (average 761/month for 2026), which is more families than we served in all of 2023. That means that we have doubled the number of families that we served from just three years ago. We have been successful at finding low cost and free items at MidOhio by diligently monitoring their “shopping list.” We bought over 32,500 pounds from MOFC in June; our per meal cost is below \$0.70 per person.



We continue to collect, sort, and deliver “gently used” items donated by our wonderful parishioners. In June, we provided these items to Vinton County St. Francis Center, Westerville Senior Citizens, Bishop Griffin Resource Center, Open Shelter, and St. Dominic’s (free café). They are all MOST appreciative.

Our normal hours of operation are from **10:00 a.m.-Noon, Monday-Friday and 6:00-8:00 p.m. on Thursday**. We are located within the PSC building (the old convent). All are welcome to visit the location to observe what we do, and if the Spirit moves you, become a part of our Ministry. We are always in need of more volunteers.

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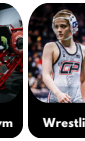
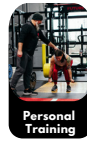
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
