If you are new to Family Faith Formation at Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish, welcome! Rather than following a traditional weekly PSR model for religious education, we view faith formation as a journey the entire family takes together. In support of parents as primary educators in the faith, our parish is pleased to offer Pathways, a Family Faith Formation program. This program is used for sacramental preparation and ongoing faith formation. During these sessions, families come together for prayer, learning, and hands-on activities that help both parents and children grow in their understanding of the Catholic faith and deepen their relationship with God and one another. It is designed to assist families in nurturing and passing on the Catholic tradition while giving busy families a program designed with flexibility. All families with children in grades 1-8 are invited and strongly encouraged to participate in this enriching family faith formation program. Registration for the program starts with a required visit with Father O'Connor and Andrea. 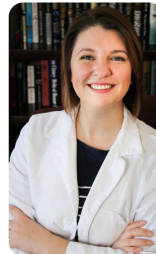

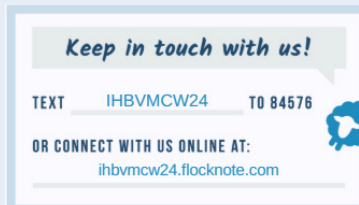
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR ESL TUTORING

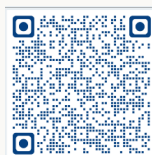


MOBILE APPS FOR CATHOLICS
